Plate Tectonics Project

Objective: To explain the Theory of Plate Tectonics and present the information in a creative format.

<u>Project Choices (choose 1 of the following):</u>

- 1. Create a piece of art (model, sculpture, painting, drawing etc.) on plate tectonics and include a 5 paragraph explanation of your art.
- 2. Create a Powerpoint presentation for plate tectonics (include at least 5 pictures).
- 3. Create a mural or collage of various plate tectonics topics. This can be done on poster board or butcher paper. Include a 5 paragraph explanation that covers the necessary research topics.
- 4. Write poems about plate tectonics. You can write one long poem that includes all the necessary information or write several poems that focus on several topics (ex. continetal drift, seafloor spreading or plate tectonics).
- 5. Write a song or rap that covers all required information.
- 6. Create a children's book about plate tectonics. Use creativity, pictures, and include all necessary information.
- 7. Think of your own idea for showing what you know about plate tectonics. (Must have teacher's approval before you begin)
